- Applicant has an overall high school GPA of 3.0 or better
- Applicant will be attending a four-year College, Junior College or Vocational Institution in the fall of 2023

Application Packet must include the following:

1. Completed Application Form
2. An official high school transcript
3. Personal statement (1-2 pages typed) describing how cancer has affected your life and how you see it affecting your future
4. Two letters of recommendation
